

Planners Course Saturday 26th November 2016

WAOC is laying on a one-day course for anyone interested in or intending to plan a level D or C colour coded event. This is intended primarily for WAOC members but members of other clubs are welcome to attend subject to spaces available.

The course will take place at the Countryside Centre at Hinchingbrooke Country Park on Saturday 26th November and will begin at 10 am and finish approximately 4 pm. The day will involve a combination of indoor training and practical activity in the surrounding parkland.

There are no "entry requirements" but some familiarity with either Purple Pen or OCAD for course setting will be an advantage. Participants are expected to bring their own laptop computer on the day with either Purple Pen, or, preferably, OCAD software. WAOC can provide OCAD 10 Course setting licences for WAOC members if required.

Some pre-session preparation will be required, also involving a computer with OCAD or Purple Pen.

The course will be run by Graham and Caroline Louth of WAOC.

The cost of attendance will be £20, which WAOC will subsidise for WAOC members who agree to plan an event for the club.
