Something from the editor (Blanka Sengerová)...

The summer holidays are now well under way, a number of WAOC juniors are busy attending summer training tours and others have undoubtedly just taken part in the Scottish 6 Days. Just to look back a bit further to events that have happened since the last Junior Jabber...

The only WAOC junior that made it to the <u>Springtime in Shropshire weekend</u> $(25^{th}/26^{th})$ May) was **Thomas Hemingway** (M10A) – congratulations for coming 3^{rd} on Day 1.

At the EAOA AGM at the end of June, the final <u>EAGAL results for 2002</u> were announced. Out of the WAOC juniors, we have the following EAGAL champions:

During the weekend of the 28th/29th June Walton Chasers hosted this year's <u>Junior Interregional Championships</u> in Cannock Chase. The WAOC juniors that were part of EA's team were M18: **Peter Gardner**; M16: **Simon Gardner**; M14: **Jamie Taylor**, **Edward Louth**; W18: **Helen Gardner**. Well done to everyone who took part, and congratulations for the especially good results from Helen who finished 4th, Jamie finished a very solid 14th out of 37 M14 competitors. As for the relays, the men's EA teams were placed 7th (**Simon Gardner**, **Edward Louth**, Lawrence Ball) and 13th (James Lyne, **Jamie Taylor**, Ed Kelleher) out of some 24 teams, whilst the women's teams were placed 20th and 21st. Overall, East Anglia finished 6th out of the 11 regional teams.

The first year of the <u>SMILE league</u> has now successfully come to its close with events at Ampthill, Hinchingbrooke, Therfield Heath, and Fairlands Valley since the last issue of Junior Jabber, the results of which are included in this issue. Also included are the final standings and a report from Ursula Oxburgh, who devised the league and coordinated it. Congratulations to the winners.

Some of the of the most dedicated juniors attending the SMILE events were from King's College School Cambridge (and now also WAOC), many of whom had their first experiences of orienteering last autumn when Ursula, Nicola, Anne and Caroline put together a set of PE lessons introducing orienteering to them. Peter Palmer relays: advance notice

This is a junior equivalent of the Harvester, being a relay competition run partly at night (or rather dawn) and partly during the early morning hours when it starts to get light. The event takes place every year at the end of September or early in October, with event locations rotating between different clubs and hence also areas. Teams of 8 are usually entered to split the equivalent courses of 2 x RED (run as the earliest legs), 2 x ORANGE, 1 x YELLOW, 2 x LIGHT GREEN and 1 x GREEN between themselves, which means that juniors of different ability levels from a club can join forces and run their own course with an aim to score points for the club.

Three different trophies are awarded, the Peter Palmer Trophy (teams of 8 Juniors M/W12–18), the Joan George Trophy (teams of 8 Juniors M/W12–18 with combined BOF ages totalling 120 or less) and the Norwich Orienteering Club Anniversary (teams of 5 Juniors M/W12-18 from 'small clubs'). This allows smaller clubs or clubs with younger juniors to be able to gain some credit.



First experience of orienteering

I first started orienteering when four ladies came to school. Every P.E. lesson we practised orienteering .We first started by learning how to read a map and what the symbols meant.

Then we went outside onto to Front pitch, for which we had been given a map showing various control points. We had use the map to go to a particular control that had a flag that looked like this:



Dangling from the flag was a letter. We filled in a card by going to each control and writing down the letter.

Next we had a kind of orienteering competition around the school. We had a punching card and a map and had to run the set course as fast as we could punching the card at each control.

The best P.E. lesson was when we went down to Coe Fen where we had a proper competition and some mothers came to help with recording the times.

Since then I have been to Thetford Forest, Bedford and Nottingham Forest to do Badge Events. Each time I have become more confident and hope to do lots more this year.

I hope more people will get involved in orienteering !! It's fun !!
